Analyst Report

This popular ETF offers exposure to the short end of the maturity curve, with exposure to all types of bonds that have maturities between one and five years. BSV is light on both interest rate risk and credit risk, and as such will generally deliver a relatively low expected return. BSV can be a great safe haven to park assets in volatile markets, and is likely to offer more in terms of yield than comparable funds focusing on T-Bills.
