## Xtrackers Russell US Multifactor ETF

### Analyst Report

The Xtrackers Russell US Multifactor ETF (DEUS) tracks an index of U.S. equities that selects, and weights securities based on quality, size, volatility, momentum, and value. DEEF debuted in 2015 and is priced competitively but hasn't gained as much traction as rivals with better brand recognition, like Goldman Sachs and JPMorgan.

DEUS has plenty of competition in the multi-factor U.S. equity space including the Goldman Sachs ActiveBeta U.S. Large Cap Equity ETF (GSLC), the Invesco S&P 500 High Dividend Low Volatility ETF (SPHD), or the JPMorgan Diversified Return US Equity ETF (JPUS). The U.S. equity space also includes ultra-low-cost plain-vanilla rivals like the iShares S&P 500 ETF (IVV) and the Vanguard Total Stock Market ETF (VTI). They lack fancy factors but offer similar exposure and great liquidity at a fraction of the price.
