Fidelity Blue Chip Growth ETF

Analyst Report

The Fidelity Blue Chip Growth ETF (FBCG) is an actively managed fund that invests in large cap U.S. stocks with earnings growth potential and sustainable business models. The fund's managers aim to identify stocks that have been "mispriced by the market." It is one of Fidelity's contributions to the new space of actively managed, non-transparent ETFs. Would-be issuers lobbied regulators for years for permission to introduce ETFs run by stock pickers that don't disclose their holdings. Firms like Fidelity wanted to protect their secret sauce from prying eyes. Fidelity was among a handful of firms that won approval in 2019. It remains to be seen whether ETF investors will be as excited as issuers about the prospect. An investment in an active fund is ultimately a bet on the manager's ability to outperform the market — something many stock pickers fail to achieve. That's a big reason why the biggest winners in the ETF marketplace have been cheap and transparent index products. FBCG, which debuted in June 2020, is reasonably priced for active management, though it looks expensive in an industry dominated by ultra-low-cost index funds. Investors might compare fund performance to plain vanilla U.S. index funds like the Vanguard Total Stock Market ETF (VTI) and the iShares Core S&P 500 ETF (IVV).
