Fidelity Low Volatility Factor ETF

Analyst Report

The Fidelity Low Volatility Factor ETF (FDLO) tracks a proprietary index of large- and mid-cap U.S. stocks that are less susceptible to market swings. The fund's sector allocations are broadly similar to the Russell 1000 index, though there is some variation. FDLO owns more than 100 securities, and so may not be diversified enough to stand alone as a core U.S. equity holding. It is more likely to be useful to investors seeking to overlay a low-vol tilt on top of a core allocation to U.S. markets. There has been a proliferation of factor funds in recent years, and investors can compare FDLO to rivals like the iShares Edge MSCI Min Vol U.S.A. ETF (USMV) or the Invesco S&P 500 Low Volatility ETF (SPLV). FDLO is reasonably priced for the segment, though there are cheaper funds available.
