Franklin Investment Grade Corporate ETF

Analyst Report

The Franklin Liberty Investment Grade Corporate ETF (FLCO) is an actively managed fund that invests in U.S.-dollar denominated investment-grade corporate bonds. The fund caps overseas exposure at 40% of assets and may invest up to 15% of the portfolio in non-U.S. dollar denominated securities. FLCO is reasonably priced for an active ETF, though there are less expensive options out there. Bonds have been one of the bright spots for active managers, and many bond ETFs manage to outperform their benchmarks — something stock pickers often fail to achieve. An investment in FLCO is ultimately a bet on the manager's ability to beat the market. Investors can compare FLCO to the iShares iBoxx USD Investment Grade Corporate Bond ETF (LQD), a giant in the indexed bond space.
