Franklin Dynamic Municipal Bond ETF

Analyst Report

The Franklin Dynamic Municipal Bond ETF (FLMI) is an actively managed fund that invests in municipal securities whose interest is free from federal income taxes. The fund attempts to maintain a maturity of three to 10 years and does not invest more than 15% of its portfolio in any one state. It has a shorter maturity target than the Franklin Municipal Green Bond ETF (FLMB), which may be appealing for investors who prefer short- to medium-term fixed income investments. FLMI is reasonably priced for active management, though it's a bit pricey for the segment. Investors can compare it to index-tracking funds like the iShares National AMT-Free Muni Bond ETF (MUB) or the Vanguard Tax-Exempt Bond Index ETF (VTB).
