## Fidelity Limited Term Bond ETF

### Analyst Report

The Fidelity Limited Term Bond ETF (FLTB) is an actively managed bond fund that invests in investment-grade securities. FLTB aims to provide a higher rate of income, and normally maintains an average maturity between two and five years. The fund may invest in lower-quality securities or derivatives that increase leverage. The fund is managed to have the same overall interest rate risk as the Fidelity Limited Term Composite Index. The management fee is reasonable for active management, though there are cheaper options available. Investors may want to compare FLTB to funds like the Vanguard Short-Term Corporate Bond Fund (VCSH) or the iShares Short-Term Corporate Bond Fund (IGSB).
