## Fidelity MSCI Financials Index ETF

### Analyst Report

The Fidelity MSCI Financials Index ETF (FNCL) is one of several options for investors looking to gain access the U.S. financial sector, a corner of the domestic equity market that generally exhibits significant volatility. As a sector-specific ETF, FNCL is most appropriate for those looking to implement a tactical tilt or carry out a sector rotation strategy, and probably has little use for those building a long-term, buy-and-hold portfolio. This fund is heavily skewed towards large caps but does also include some mid- and small-cap exposure. With more than 300 holdings, FNCL offers considerably deeper exposure than the ultra-popular Financial Select Sector SPDR Fund (XLF). As of June 2020, FNCL is competitively priced against rivals including XLF, the Vanguard Financials ETF (VFH), and the iShares U.S. Financials ETF (IYF), which as of June 2020 was one of the more expensive options in the category. Short-term traders will likely prefer the size and liquidity of XLF.
