## Fidelity Quality Factor ETF

### Analyst Report

The Fidelity Quality Factor ETF (FQAL) tracks a proprietary index that selects U.S. stocks based on factors like higher profitability, a good balance sheet, and stable cash flows. The fund owns about 125 securities. As with many single-factor funds, FQAL may not be diversified enough stand alone as a core U.S. equity holding. It is more likely to be useful to investors seeking to overlay Fidelity's version of a quality tilt on top of a core allocation to U.S. markets. FQAL is reasonably priced for a factor fund, but there are cheaper options available. There has been a proliferation of factor funds in recent years, and investors can compare FQAL to rivals like the iShares Edge MSCI U.S.A. Quality Factor ETF (QUAL), the Schwab Fundamental U.S. Large Cap Company Index ETF (FNDX), or the JPMorgan U.S. Quality Factor ETF (JQUA).
