Analyst Report

The Global X NASDAQ 100 Covered Call ETF (QYLD) follows a "covered call" strategy in which the ETF buys the stocks in the Nasdaq 100 index, then sells corresponding call options to generate a little extra income for investors.

For investors who want the added yield without the hassle of getting into options trading, QYLD delivers a little something extra on top of the same companies in the Invesco QQQ Trust (QQQ). QYLD and similar strategies could be appropriate for investors who want exposure to Nasdaq stocks with a bit of downside protection should stocks plummet.
