Invesco S&P MidCap 400 Revenue ETF

Analyst Report

This ETF is one of several ETFs available that offers exposure to mid cap U.S. stocks, an asset class that can make up a significant portion of long-term, buy-and-hold portfolios. As such, this ETF may be more appealing to those in the portfolio construction process as opposed to short term traders. Mid cap stocks are appealing to many because they still have significant growth potential but they are less risky than their small and micro cap brethren. While many products in this category utilize a cap-weighted system, RWK weights companies by top line revenues instead. Due to this the weightings of the fund are far different than those using a cap weighting system, even though both styles still chose from the same number of funds. In total RWK holds about 400 securities and has less than 20% of its portfolio in its top ten securities suggesting that a solid level of diversification is present. Unfortunately, the expense ratio for this product is far higher than some of the cap weighted funds but for those willing to put up with a higher expense ratio RWK could make for a key building block in numerous buy and hold portfolios.
