This ETF offers exposure to the short end of the maturity curve, focusing on securities with one to three years to maturity. SCHO is light on both interest rate risk and credit risk, and as such will generally deliver a relatively low expected return. SCHO can be a great safe haven to park assets in volatile markets, especially for those with Charles Schwab accounts that can trade the security for free.
