This popular ETF offers exposure to the short end of the maturity curve, focusing on securities with less than three years to maturity. SHY is light on both interest rate risk and credit risk, and as such will generally deliver a relatively low expected return. SHY can be a great safe haven to park assets in volatile markets, but won't deliver much in the way of current yield.
