## FlexShares Credit-Scored US Corporate Bond Index Fund Analyst Report

The FlexShares Credit-Scored U.S. Corporate Bond Index Fund (SKOR) is part of Northern Trust's sizable stable of ETFs built with the firm's twist on factor investing. SKOR follows a proprietary index that looks for investment-grade bonds maturing in one to 10 years. SKOR then uses an in-house scoring strategy to weight those bonds based on measures of the issuer's quality and value, such as profitability and solvency. To prevent unintended concentrations, the index imposes limits on issuers, individual bonds, sectors and duration. The index is reconstituted monthly.

While SKOR's expense ratio is just a smidge higher than average for the ETFdb corporate bond category, it charges significantly more than some of the cheapest intermediate-term bond ETFs. Cost-conscious investors who aren't sold on the FlexShares factor twist might consider lower-cost funds like State Street's SPDR Portfolio Intermediate-Term Corporate Bond ETF (SPIB), iShares Intermediate-Term Corporate Bond ETF (IGIB) or the Vanguard Intermediate-Term Corporate Bond ETF (VCIT).
