## Vanguard Intermediate-Term Treasury ETF

### Analyst Report

This ETF offers exposure to intermediate term government bonds, focusing on Treasuries that mature in three to ten years. As such, interest rate exposure for this product will be moderate; VGLT offers exposure to longer-dated Treasuries while VGSH is an option for those looking to focus on the short end of the maturity curve. VGIT probably doesn't have much appeal as a core holding, since the overlap with broad-based funds such as BND will be significant. But this ETF can be a useful tool for tilting exposure towards Treasuries without a bias towards either end of the maturity spectrum. Like most Vanguard ETFs, VGIT is among the cheapest options available; commission free trading in Vanguard accounts may increase the cost appeal to those keeping an eye on fees. Other options offering similar exposure include IEL, FIVZ, SCHR, and ITE; the effective durations and yields on these products may vary slightly.
