This ETF offers broad based exposure to the developed economies of Europe, spreading holdings across more than a dozen markets. As such, this ETF can be an efficient tool for investors looking to tilt exposure towards this region of the world. Those seeking broader exposure to ex-U.S. developed markets may prefer a fund such as VEA, which includes Pacific economies as well. For those seeking exposure to developed European economies, VGK is perhaps the best ETF option available. This ETF offers exposure that is balanced across countries, sectors, and individual holdings; with nearly 500 component securities, concentration to any one name is minimal. Moreover, the expense ratio is among the lowest in the ETFdb Category, making VGK one of the most cost efficient ways to access developed Europe's equity markets.
