Invesco Variable Rate Investment Grade ETF

Analyst Report

The Invesco Variable Rate Investment Grade ETF is an actively-managed fund that tries to boost income while limiting vulnerability to interest rate increases. The fund will invest in investment-grade, variable rate securities, including floating rate U.S. Treasuries, mortgage-backed securities, asset backed debt, collateralized loan obligations, corporate debt, U.S. agency debt. The fund may invest up to 20% of its portfolio in junk-rated debt. The fund aims to limit duration, a measure of sensitivity to interest rate increases, to one year. Bonds with shorter duration typically take less of a hit from rate hikes than longer-term debt. Variable-rate debt adds another layer of protection since coupons adjust along with interest rates. Fund fees are reasonable, although there are lower cost indexed ETFs that track floating rate debt. VRIG could be a good choice for investors who are willing to accept a little more risk in order to bolster income while limiting interest rate risk.
