State Street Energy Select Sector SPDR Premium Income ETF Analyst Report

XLEI is one of State Street's new premium income funds that combines the exposure of their original State Street Energy Select Sector SPDR ETF (XLE) with an active call options overlay. The underlying fund provides access to U.S. energy sector stocks from the S&P 500 as a market-cap weighted index while generating income via covered call options with expirations under one year. At 35 bps, XLEI is certainly not as cheap as the vanilla version XLE's 8 bps, but investors may find the reduced volatility well worth the cost.
