State Street Industrial Select Sector SPDR Premium Income ETF Analyst Report

XLII is one of State Street's new premium income funds that combines the exposure of their original State Street Industrial Select Sector SPDR ETF (XLI) with an active call options overlay. The underlying fund provides access to U.S. industrial sector stocks from the S&P 500 as a market-cap weighted index while generating income via covered call options with expirations under one year. At 35 bps, XLII is certainly not as cheap as the vanilla version XLI's 8 bps, but investors may find the reduced volatility well worth the cost.
