Baillie Gifford Long Term Global Growth ETF

Fund Description

BGGG is an actively managed global equity ETF that invests in companies the adviser believes have strong long-term growth potential. The fund maintains a concentrated portfolio of growth-oriented businesses across developed and emerging markets and typically holds investments for extended periods.

BGGG invests in a concentrated portfolio of 30 to 60 companies selected through a bottom-up research process focused on long-term growth prospects rather than benchmark weightings. The fund can invest across developed and emerging markets, including significant exposure to China, and is not constrained by market capitalization, sector, or geographic allocations. Portfolio managers evaluate factors such as competitive advantages, industry positioning, management quality, financial strength, and valuation when selecting investments. The strategy typically maintains a long investment horizon of at least five years, resulting in relatively low portfolio turnover. The fund may invest in IPOs, depositary receipts, and non-US securities and does not generally hedge currency exposure, leaving investors fully exposed to foreign currency fluctuations.
