These companies are chosen for their attractive investment attributes including their products or services, strong management and strategic direction, and their sustainable business practices which involve environmental and/or social impacts to transform their business models. A thematic approach is utilized to select stocks based on investment themes, qualitative and quantitative fundamental analysis, and consideration of ESG matters. The advisor also eliminates, from the broad equity universe, companies that display material negative impacts involving their business activities. BKUS launched alongside BKIS, covering the Developed Markets Ex-North America equity space, and BKES, following Emerging Markets companies, to round out BNY Mellons sustainable equity suite.
