It integrates research, portfolio design, management, and trading to achieve its objectives. The selection process begins with a market-cap-weighted universe of eligible US firms of any market capitalization. In assessing relative price and profitability, the adviser reviews fundamental factors, such as price-to-book value, price-to-earnings, price-to-cash flow, earnings-to-book value, and earnings-to-assets ratios. However, these criteria are subject to change from time to time. The adviser aims for broad diversification and adjusts exposure based on short-term criteria like price momentum, short-run reversals, and investment characteristics. Additionally, the fund may use futures contracts and options to manage market exposure.
