Fund Description

SIXD aims for specific buffered losses and capped gains on the SPDR S&P 500 ETF Trust over a specific holdings period. The actively managed fund holds options and collateral.

FactSet Analyst Report

SIXD uses options in an effort to moderate losses on the S&P 500 over a six-month period that starts each June and resets in December or vice versa). The fund foregoes some upside return as well as the S&P 500s dividend component because the options are written on the price (not total) return version of the index. In exchange for preventing the realization of the first 10% of the S&P 500s losses, investors forego upside participation above a certain threshold, which is reset semi-annually. Investors who buy at any other time than the semi-annual reset day may have a very different protection and buffer zone. The issuer publishes effective interim levels daily on its website. Even if shares are held for the entire outcome period, the outcome may differ from the intended results. The targeted buffers and caps do not include the funds expense ratio. The fund is actively managed, resets semi-annually, and uses listed options exclusively. Prior to December 22, 2025, the fund was listed on the NYSE Arca under the name AllianzIM US Large Cap 6 Month Buffer10 Jun/Dec ETF.
